What if there
were a pill that could
help prevent HIV?

THERE IS.

*Pre-exposure prophylaxis
(or PrEP) is a way to prevent
people who do not have
HIV from getting the HIV
virus, by taking one pill
every day as prescribed.*

In most cases, PrEP is covered by insurance.

We are happy to check with your insurance during your appointment to make sure PrEP medication is covered under your plan.

- Prescription co-pay assistance is available, if needed.
- The Ready, Set, PrEP Program makes PrEP medication available at no cost for people who qualify. You must:
 - test negative for HIV
 - have a valid prescription from your healthcare provider
 - not have insurance that covers prescription drugs

Find out if PrEP is right for you.
